Conversation Starter: Tell your child about a time when God helped you have the fruit of the Spirit. What happened and how did God help you?

Encouragement for You *Need some inspiration on the journey?*

The fruit of the Spirit is present in our lives when we are abiding in Christ and are spiritually healthy. The attributes named in Galatians 5:22-23 are signs that God is doing a work in our lives. Think about what that would look like on a daily basis. Does your joy fluctuate depending on the craziness of life? Do you show peace and patience in spite of the good and difficult? Is your service filled with goodness and kindness? Spend time with God to grow in these things. Be honest when you fail, and ask for forgiveness from Him and from others. Your child sees your example of how you discover God's grace, and it will influence his or her spiritual growth too!

Make It Stick

Do you need a creative activity to help with memorizing verses? Read this suggested activity and look for a time this week when you can do this with your child!

Verse Recorder — Have your child record himself or herself saying the verse five times perfectly, in five different kinds of voices. Have your child watch the video and then try to repeat the verse on his or her own. Watch and repeat until your child has the verse memorized.
